Amanda Morales - Amanda was born and raised in Puerto Rico, but currently resides in Florida. She served as a 6 month “Reveal” Missionary with us from May - November 2015. We fell in love with her. Camila (Cami) Gomez - Cami is 22 years old. She is from Argentina. She feels God calling her to full-time missionary service in Latin America. She has felt called to get further preparation in a year-long missionary training school in El Salvador through the ministry of Castillo del Rey (King's Castle). It is an intense course where she will be challenged greatly in many ways. In addition to the monthly fees (\$200), she has to raise money throughout the year to go on short-term mission trips. Her first is coming up at the end of January and she has to raise \$300 for the trip. Her small church in Argentina is supporting MANY youth (in addition to Cami) who are currently serving as missionaries or are also getting similar preparation, so they are not able to help as much as they would like. We had the privilege of helping Cami with her travel to El Salvador and were able to get cheaper flights for her by flying her through Mexico.
